FUTURAGE is funded by the European Commission under the Seventh Framework Programme, to create the definitive Road Map for ageing research in Europe for the next 10–15 years.

This leaflet shows how the various activities and events of the project are arranged to build, between 2009 and 2011, consensus across Europe to create a consensus-led Road Map.

Through a carefully planned series of consultations at national and European level, academic and non-academic stakeholders – including older people – have the opportunity to input directly into the main priorities on ageing and health for the next 10–15 years.

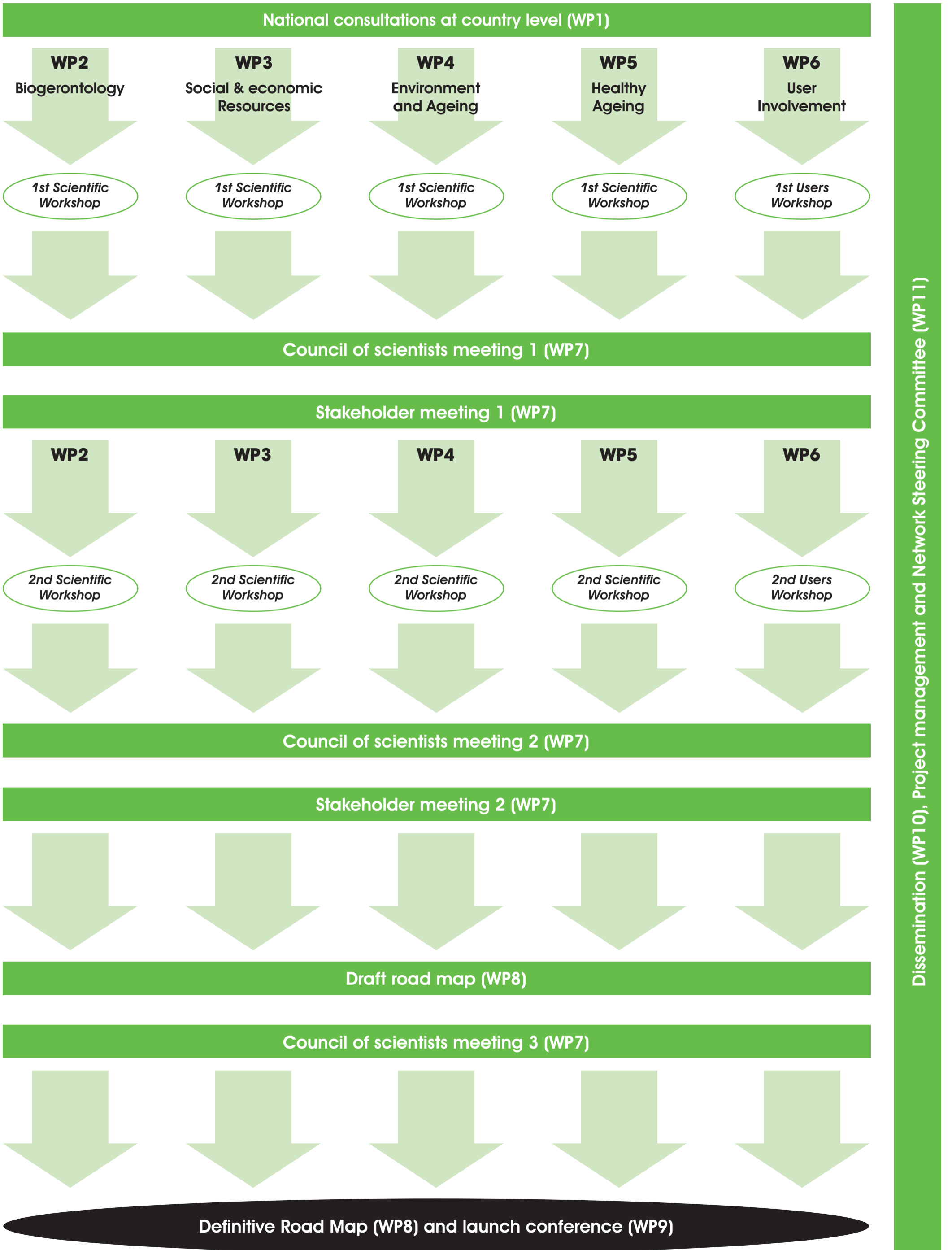
